Now, the fun part is when you're able to take some clips, and put it together to be a loop and share it with your friends. **Can you break it down in terms of the multiple processes and what you are doing for each one? **Paul Graham:** There are different ways of doing loops, but the main idea of it is like... The loop will happen in the software. When you open it up, there are three main frames. The first frame is the image editor. You add multiple clips, and then you select your looping option. For looping, there's an option where you just want to loop a specific time. Or, for example, I want to use my entire video, I want to loop the entire video. I can choose to use the start time or the end time, and then I can select how many times I want to loop. The next frame is the soundtrack editor. You can add multiple clips that are going to play over the audio track. You can also add some sounds if you want. The last frame is the playback editor, where you can select what type of video player you want to use. You can use a timeline, or you can select to use the default player. There's also a lot of options like, you can even make it so that you just record a webcam or microphone into the loop. **It sounds like you have to choose one way or the other. There's no way you could have a playlist that would let you do both of them. **Paul Graham:** That's correct. **You mentioned adding videos, I've seen people have videos that you combine with multiple videos. I was wondering, how do you create the loop, like for how long you loop it, and how many videos you can use. **Paul Graham:** Right. You can use up to 100 videos in a loop. If you want to use more, you can use the timeline that you see in the image editor. When you use the timeline, you can use up to the 999th clip that you want to loop. When you do a video, for example, you will only be able to use the first nine of your video, so you have to select the rest of them, and then you can combine them in the image editor. **
