The plugin receives a series of events through an intent that will be passed to an activity. The activity has the following action set: ActivityCompat.startActivity(intent, android.content.Intent.ACTION_MAIN, android.content.Intent.FLAG_ACTIVITY_NEW_TASK); However, once the activity starts up, the currently running activity of the phone gets closed. Is there a way to pass the events that are received through the intent to the activity without closing the current activity? The plugin is registered with the phone and receives events the same way as it receives from the activity. A: In my application I am using a situation similar to yours. But I am missing the Plugin Manager concept. So the way I've found to solve this is to use a custom onNewIntent() method in the manifest. The idea is to restore the activity in its old state (the default one) and at the end of the
